



Superhero Puppets

Let's make a Superhero Puppet in celebration of National Superhero Week, 28th August-3rd September 2017 and Father's Day. You may want to give it to your very own Superhero family member or friend, or keep it for yourself.

Your child will need:

- Popstick
- Crayons/textas
- Glue
- Coloured paper or cardboard

Instructions:

- Colour the popstick using your favourite colour.
- Cut out a triangle (cape) and small rectangle (mask) from the cardboard/paper.
- Glue the cape and mask onto the popstick.
- Draw eyes, mouth and Superhero symbol onto the popstick.

Extension Ideas:

- Who is your Superhero family member or friend?
- Does your Superhero puppet have a name?
- What special powers does your Superhero have?
- Change the shape of your Superhero cape.
- Use larger popsticks for younger children. These can be bought from stores such as The Reject Shop and Cheap as Chips.
