TANAMANAN TO THE TOTAL TO THE T



- Start with a large empty Cardboard Box
- Remove or fold in the top of box to create an opening
- Use cardboard to cut out ears, decorate with white paper and cotton balls (or whatever you wish) and stick ears to the rear of the box using tape or glue
- Cut a n-shaped tongue flap out of the front of the box but leave it attached along the bottom
- Stick a similarly shaped bit of coloured card or paper to the tongue flap so that it looks like a tongue
- Decorate the front of your creation with eyes, nose and whiskers
- Find some soft or hollow balls and allow Playgroupers to stand back and throw the balls into the bunny - which will then roll back out of the mouth

Try making different types of animals using this method and consult children about shapes for ears, tongues, etc. Involve Playgroupers in the making and decorating of their new game. Why not try little hand sized versions to use with pom pom balls, cotton balls or foam?







during the cooler months...

Too cold to go outside...? Bring the outside in!

As the colder months start to approach, many parents are looking for creative activities that children can enjoy indoors...



Bring your outdoor equipment in

If you have safe free-standing outdoor equipment (slides, tunnels or climbing frames) then don't be afraid to bring them inside and set up on a soft surface with cushions for a soft fall, if required.

Sand Pit

If you have a large tray or container why not partially fill up with sand and set it up in one of your wet areas around the house. Spills can be easily vacuumed and it can provide endless hours of fun!

Cubby House

Make your own cubbies out of large boxes, cardboard or cover a table and chairs in a large sheet. Provide cushions and rugs to make the cubby cosy and accessorize with items such as tea sets. You can also use this idea to make a tent and set up camp in your own playgroup or lounge room. Don't forget your sleeping bags, torches, etc.

Obstacle Course

Invite children to help set up an obstacle course with everyday objects you may already have in the room. You can step in and out of boxes, climb over/jump onto cushions, crawl under tables and balance on rope or lines on the ground.

You can also try taping up a 'spider web' to a door frame or in a hallway and sticking pom poms or cotton balls to the web for children to crawl through and channel their inner spider.

Box Play

Make your own furniture out of large boxes. You can make tables, ovens, microwaves, etc. You can also use large boxes to make cars, rockets, boats and shop fronts. Smaller boxes can be used to make smaller appliances and other pretend play props.

Gardening

Why not teach your children about how plants grow and what they need to survive? Use foam trays or egg cartons (providing there are no egg allergies) with damp cotton wool to grow seeds like mustard or cress. You may also like to use those seeds to make a hairy head.

Flower cuttings can be put into a glass of water for the children to observe the roots forming over time. You can also grow your own sunflower seeds in pots.

Hide and Seek

There's no reason why Hide and Seek needs to be played outdoors. There are some great hiding spots inside and an indoor game of Hide and Seek can be a fun and interactive way to entertain children indoors. You can try adding a modern twist to the game by turning off the lights and hiding objects around the house for playgroupers to seek with a torch.

Use your imagination and ask the children about their favourite outside activities - then adapt them to work inside.





THE RESIDENCE OF THE PARTY OF T

TO PROPERTY

You will need:

- Jelly (assorted colours)
- Boiling water
- Cold water
- Assorted plastic trays

Prepare jelly the day before. Place on a large tray and away you go.

You Will Need:

- 1 Tbs Self-Raising Flour
- 1 Tbs Salt
- Food Colouring

Mix all the ingredients together using enough water to make a smooth paste (add different food colours to make different coloured paints).

Paint on thick paper or card and then microwave on high until the paint is dry.

Ice Cube Building

You Will Need:

- Water
- Ice cube tray
- Ice cream container (or similar size)
- Food Colouring

Mix water and food colouring and pour into containers and trays. Allow enough time to freeze. Place ice in large troth with other objects to play with.

Cloop

You Will Need:

- · 2 cups Corn Flour
- Cold Water
- Food Colouring

Add water gradually to cornflour until it is smooth and runny enough to be dribbled.

Add food colouring.



Wax Painting

You will need:

- Wax crayons
- Paper
- · Pinch of Edicol dye
- Water
- Plastic Container
- Wide paint brush

Use wax crayons to draw pictures. Mix the Edicol dye with water and paint all over the picture. The wax will show through.

Cloud Play-dough

You will need:

- 8 cups plain flour
- 1 cup cooking oil

In a large container, combine the flour and dough using a spoon.

Keep covered for storage. Do not mix with water.

Chocolate Play-dough

You will need:

- 2 cups of all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup of table salt
- 1/2 cup of cocoa
- 1.5 cups of boiling water
- 3 tablespoons of vegetable oil
- 1/2 teaspoon of vanilla (optional)

Put all ingredients into a large bowl. Mix well until a ball starts to form. Let cool for a few minutes and then knead it and play playdough.





Rice Play

You will need:

- 2 cups rice
- Food Colouring

Put rice into resealable bag and then drop in some food dye. Shake it around to mix and then play with it in a tray or bowl.

Coloured Water Bubbles

You will need:

- Morning fresh dishwashing liquid
- Water
- Glycerine
- Food Colouring
- Bubble blowing tool

Mix all ingredients together and blow multicoloured bubbles.

Try blowing them onto paper to see what effect they leave.

Rainbow Cotton Rais

You will need:

- ¼ Cup Flour
- ¼ Water
- Food colouring
- Cotton balls

Mix 1/4 cup of flour and 1/4 cup of water with your desired food colour for each colour of the rainbow. Add a bit more water if necessary. Then cover the cotton balls in the paint mixture.
