EASTER activities



Easter Chicken

Egg and spoon race

Make sure you hard boil the eggs first to avoid a mess, this is a good activity for outside if you have a good outdoor area at your Playgroup.

Festivities & Games

Stick the Egg on the Easter Bunny

Paint, draw or print a large Easter Bunny. Cut out large Easter eggs from colourful cardboard.

Have each child with eyes closed try to stick the Easter egg on the Easter Bunny. See who gets closest to the Bunny's hands.

Other kinds of Easter hunts

Check with the families at your playgroup that chocolate is ok, some other ideas instead of food include: a scavenger hunt, fill each plastic egg with a message for the finder (each message has something fun for each child to do during group time for example 'sing itzy bitzy spider', 'spin around 10 times' etc)

Introduce new Easter Traditions to your Playgroup

Ask your Playgroupers if they know of any new ways to celebrate Easter, try to add some of these ideas to your Playgroup



Using a fork and yellow paint, dip the fork in the paint and the dab and print on a piece of white paper. Using scissors cut a diamond for the beak and fold in half and cut out two legs in a fork like shape. Once the paint has dried stick on some eyes, or paint and draw eyes on the chicken.

The Bunny Pokey

to the tune of "The Hokey Pokey"

You put your right paws [right hand and foot] in, you take your right paws out.

You put your right paws in, and you shake them all about.

You do the Bunny Pokey, and you hop all around.

That's what it's all about!

You put your left paws in.... Your put your pink nose in... You put your floppy ears in... You put your cotton tail in... You put the whole bunny in...

Salt Dough Easter Eggs

1/2 cup of salt1/2 cup of water1 cup of flour

Add the salt and flour to a bowl and slowly add the water. Using your hands mix the dough and knead until it forms a dough like texture. Use your hands or a rolling pin to flatten the dough, and cut egg shapes from the dough using an oval biscuit cutter. Use a match stick to poke a hole at the top of each egg. It will take several days to a week for the salt dough to dry out naturally, turn them over each day so both sides can dry out. Once the dough has dried paint each egg. When this paint dries use cotton tips and white paints to decorate and make each one unique. If you want a shiny clear finish put a layer of glue on once all the paint has dried. Add a piece of string or wall and then they're ready to hung. This could be a wonderful craft project at Playgroup over several weeks.

Easter Basket

Ask each family member to bring in a recycled bottle. Recruit a family member (mum/dad/carer) to cut each one down. Use a hole puncher to put a hole in each side and carefully weave a pipe cleaner through for the handle. Place tape around the edges to help cover any sharp edges. Now it's time to hand them over to the children. Each child can decorate their Easter basket however they like-stickers, paints etc. If you have shredded paper the children might like to line the baskets. While the children are busy decorating recruit an adult to hide a few eggs around the playgroup for an Easter egg hunt. Don't forget to ensure there are enough eggs for each child. Some handy tips: allocate 2 ore 3 eggs per child, colour code them to make it more difficult (tell each member to look for a certain colour).

























HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

Playgroup Mums & Grandma's

On Sunday 10th May, many will celebrate Mother's Day. It's a day we can show our appreciation for the love, care and efforts of our mothers and mother figures - including stepmothers, grandmothers, relatives, guardians, foster mothers and close family friends.

You may like to make her breakfast in bed, have a special lunch or afternoon tea and make a homemade gift and card for her to treasure...

Hair Decoration

Make her a special decoration she can put in her hair. Stick feathers to the bottom of a patty pan and then stick on the hook side of a velcro dot (this will hold the decoration in the hair). Add a smaller patty pan and a coloured paper circle to the inside of the first patty pan. You may like to add bits of ribbon, lace, felt shapes or glitter.


Ring

Cut a small strip of paper about 1cm wide and long enough to go around your finger. Wrap it loosely around your finger and fasten with stick tape. Attach a mini patty pan and decorate it however you like to make a special ring. You could use any craft bits and pieces or colour it in with textas.

Necklace Keepsake

Draw a circle onto a piece of paper or trace around a circle shape about the size of an adult's palm. Have your child draw a picture, a handprint or stick on stickers to decorate. Then cut out the circle shape, cover both sides in clear contact, punch a small hole in the top and thread it on a piece of ribbon/string to make a keepsake necklace.

Cut squares from coloured card to make pretty mosaic pieces. On a piece of paper or cardboard draw a large heart and write above or below it'l love you to pieces'. Using glue, have your little one glue the pieces inside the heart.

A BIG HUG for You

Print cute little hand prints of your little one/s. Once they've dried, cut around them and glue them on a card. Add a small piece of wool or string and write up the top "a big hug for you". Or "I love you this much".

This is a great one for all ages, and who doesn't want a hug this Mother's Day?




